Background of Project

- Union County was approached by The Moser Group and Seasonal Ice Rinks in the Fall of 2023 to discuss operating the temporary Ice Skating Rink at Sun Valley Commons from November to January of 2023.
- After discussion with applicable departments to include Management, Procurement and Finance it was determined that we did not have adequate funds available or the necessary time to support this project in 2023.
- Parks & Recreation FY 2025 Budget Request included funding to operate the Seasonal Ice Rink in 2025.
- This funding includes all necessary equipment, training and staff to successfully operate the Ice Skating Rink.

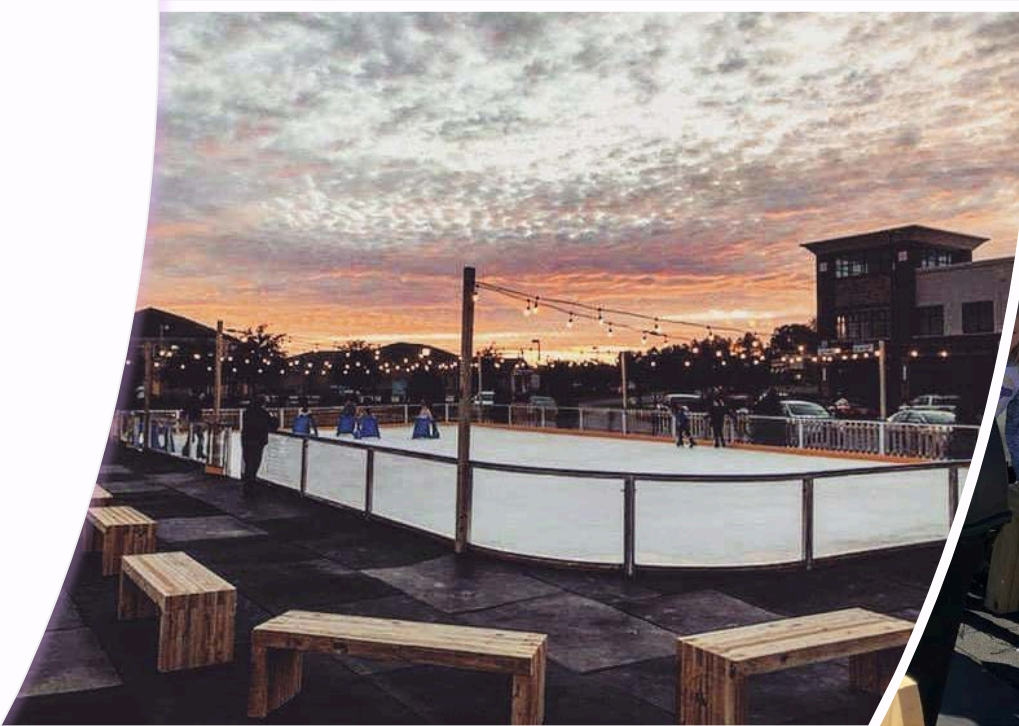
Why Operate an Ice Skating Rink

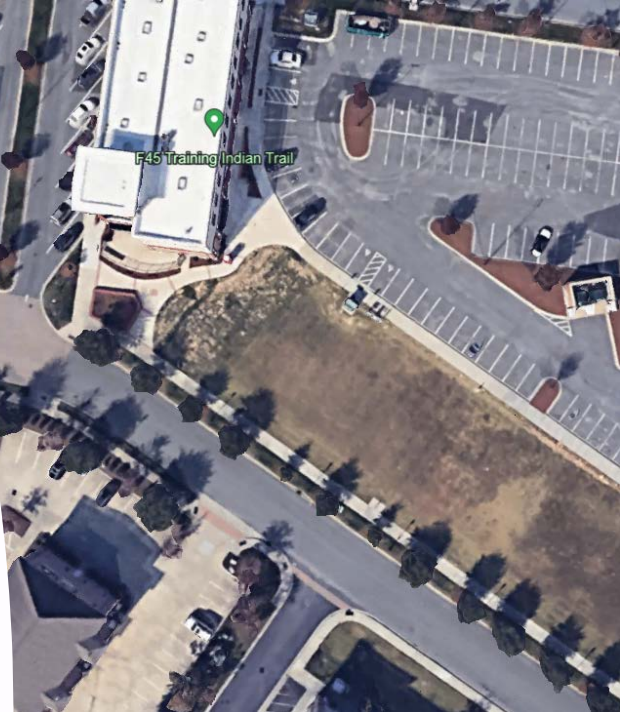
What is Provided?

- Ice rink floor system
- Refrigeration plant
- Ice rink boards
- Rental skates
- Skate storage racks
- Rubber flooring
- Zamboni
- Upper glass, netting, etc.
- Sound Systems
- Lighting Packages
- Skate rental shed
- Admission system
- Admission shed
- Temporary generators



Union County Responsibilities

- Operational aspects of the Skating Rink
- Provide staffing for the hours of operation
- Routine Maintenance to include trash pick-up and ice upkeep
- Providing reservation platform for residents to utilize
- Manage the reservations, provide POS system to accept payments, provide rental skates and overall security of the rink
- Monitor and maintain Waiver Liability Forms for residents

Financial Aspects

- (58) total days for opportunity to operate the Ice Skating Rink pending weather or maintenance issues.
- (6) Skating sessions per day at (1) hour each
- Cost will be \$12.00 per person. 3 and under will be free
- Maximum of 60 people per one hour session equals 360 people per day
- If the rink were to max out daily for each operational day the total revenue would be \$250,560.00 (Weather will play a part in amount of revenue brought in with this program)
