Re: 2014 Uncollectible Fire Fees

To the extent allowed by the North Carolina General Statutes a county's Board of Commissioners may, at its discretion, allow the write off of certain taxes and fees associated with those taxes once the 10 year statute of limitations has expired. We are requesting that the Board of County Commissioners approve the write off of the outstanding balance of fire fees associated with the 2014 tax levy. It is the opinion of the Tax Administrator's office that all available avenues of collection have been exhausted and the remaining balance of these fees are uncollectible. The amount we are requesting to be written off is \$4,338.85. Below is a breakdown of these fees.

Please consider this request to have these fees relieved from the charge.
