

#### **Charter School Invitations**

- We worked with UCPS to get a list of all the Charter Schools that are funded
- Invitations were sent to 11 charter schools representing 4,793 students
- Invitation was to discuss the following questions:
  - How are the funds received by UCPS expended
  - How often, and when was the last audit conducted
  - How much fund balance is available
- Invitation was up to five minutes to present to the BOCC
- Initially three schools expressed interest in attending but only Union Academy was able to attend.

#### **FUNDING**

### Union Academy receives its primary funding from three sources:

- State funds allocated by the General Assembly for public education
- Federal grants and subgrants awarded by USDOE
- Local pro-rata share of the per-pupil allocation for each county from which Union Academy educates children per NCGS 115C-218.105
  - Union (95%)
  - Mecklenburg (3%)
  - Stanly, Cabarrus, Anson (2%)



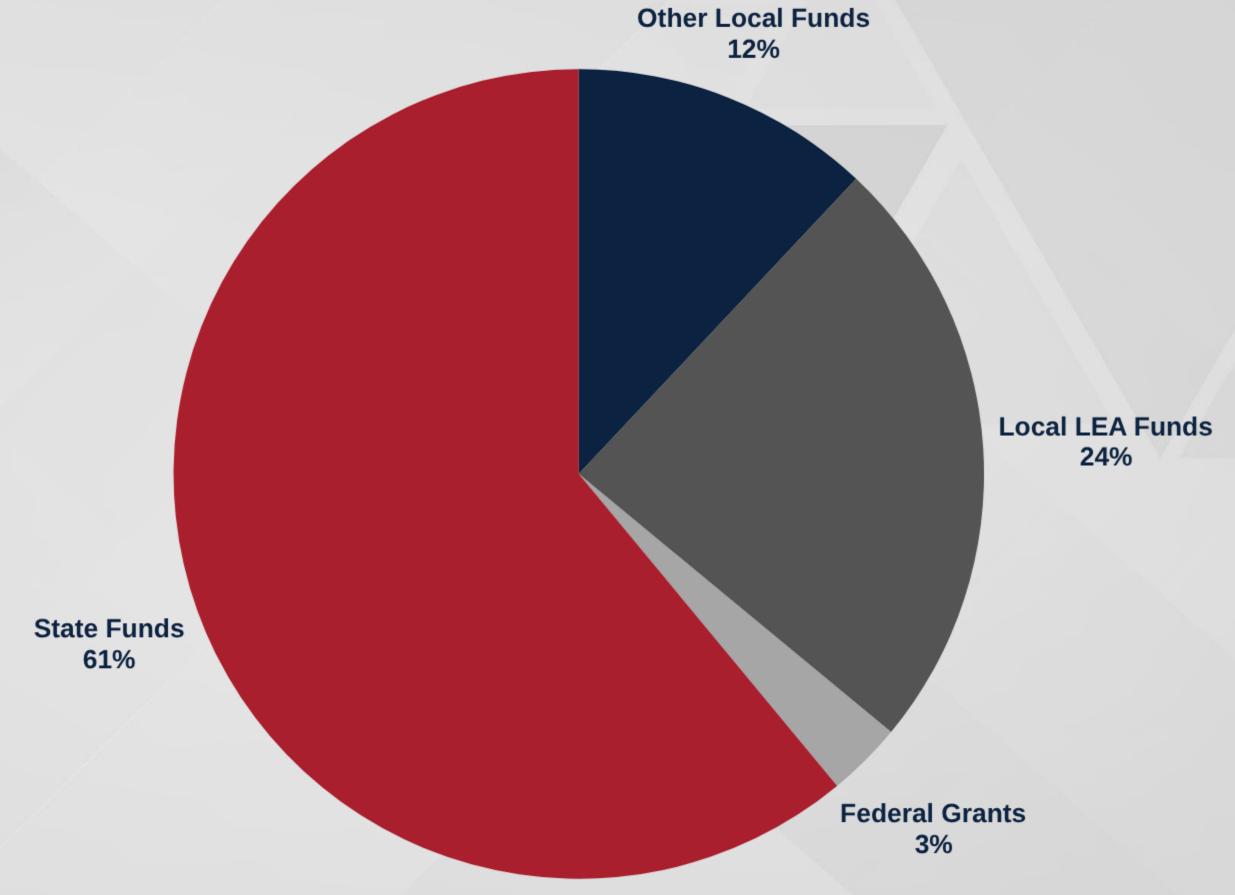

#### **EXPENDITURES**

## Union Academy maintains three primary expenditure categories:

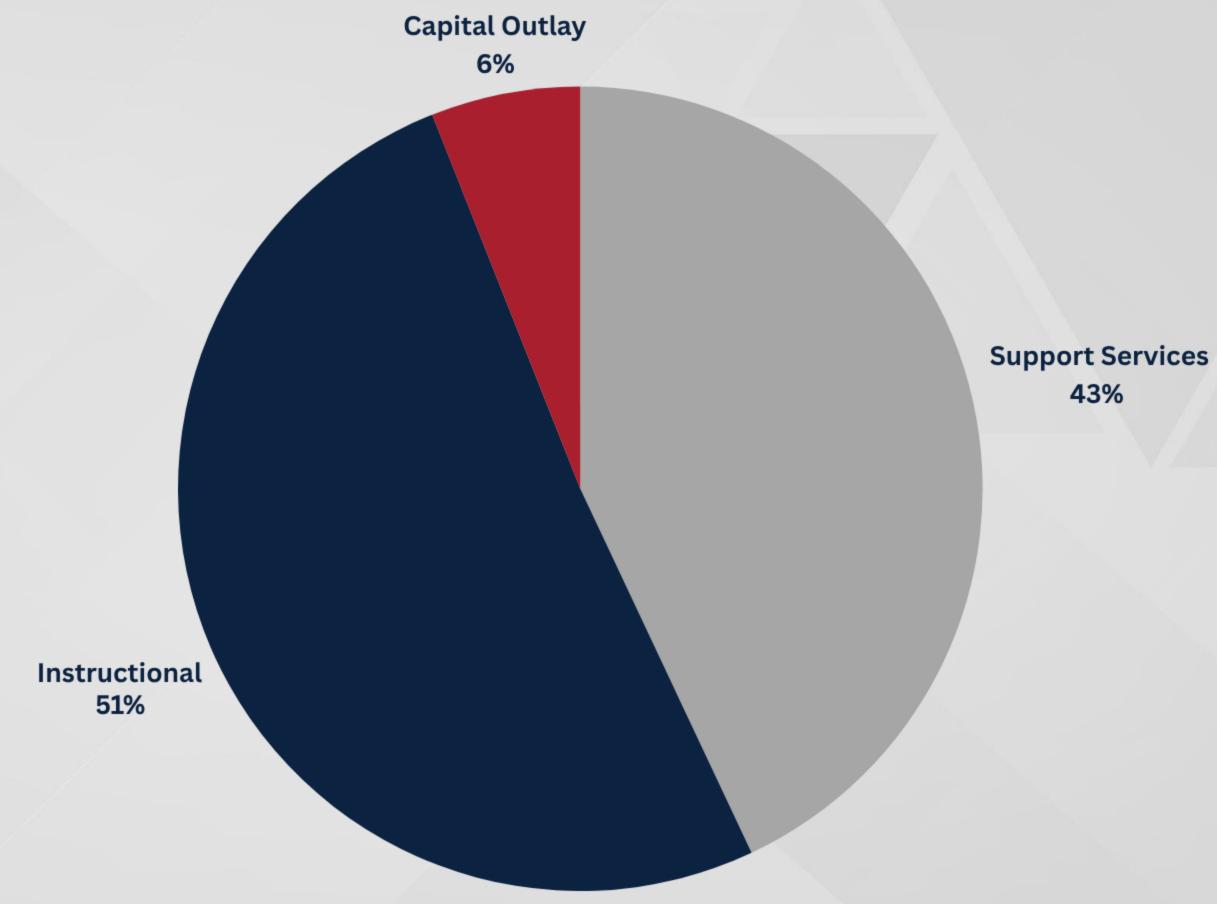
- Instructional Expenditures: Includes instructional salaries and benefits (certified), instruction supplies and programming, contracted instructional and staff development
- Support Expenditures: Includes support staff salaries and benefits (leadership, admin, nutrition, maintenance, non-certified, substitutes, etc.), contracted professional (legal, accounting, audit, SRO, grant writing, etc.), clubs and athletics, insurance, transportation, occupancy and debt service
- Capital Outlay: Includes capital maintenance of facilities, furniture, equipment, vehicles and capitalized IT infrastructure
