Program Update

- leaf Additional funding of \$127,023 in the FY26 budget to maintain current level of meals provided
- leaf Additional \$244,863 provided in the FY26 budget to address waitlist
- leaf \$50,000 will be held to help defer any additional waitlist persons from our participating municipalities
- leaf The remaining will be used to reduce our warm meal eligible waitlisted residents
- leaf With current staff we have the capacity to add 110 seniors and still maintain compliance
- leaf With the participating municipalities that will take either 32 or 54 of that capacity it both Unionville and Waxhaw participate.
- leaf This would allow the county to address either 78 or 56 from the remaining waitlist

Action Requested

I move that the Board authorize the County Manager to :

1) negotiate and execute agreements with **Wingate, Waxhaw, Mineral Springs, Marvin, Unionville, Lake Park, Wesley Chapel and Weddington**, within Union County for the purpose of receiving funds from the municipalities for the County's Senior Nutrition Program,

2) exercise any renewal or extension term options set forth in the agreements, and 3) terminate the agreements if deemed in the best interest of the County, each in the County Manager's discretion.
