

ORDINANCE APPROVING REVISION TO THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF UNION COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) heretofore enacted the “Unified Development Ordinance of Union County, North Carolina,” including any amendments thereto (the “UDO”) and the official Union County Zoning Map (“Zoning Map”); and

WHEREAS, Union County has received rezoning petition (CZ-2026-007), submitted by R. Dean Harrell, requesting a revision of the Union County Zoning Map by rezoning an approximately 3.207 acre parcel of land appearing on the tax map as tax parcel 06-042-001J along the south side of Beulah Church Road from B-2 with Conditions to B-2 with Modified Conditions (the “Rezoning Petition”); and

WHEREAS, the Union County Land Use Board considered and made a recommendation concerning approval or denial of the Rezoning Petition; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that approval of the Rezoning Petition and rezoning the subject parcel from B-2 with Conditions to B-2 with Modified Conditions is reasonable and in the public interest, including for those reasons set forth in the contemporaneously adopted consistency and reasonableness statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Union County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. The Zoning Map is hereby amended by rezoning the approximately 3.207 acre parcel appearing on the tax map as tax parcel 06-042-001J along the south side of Beulah Church Road from B-2 with Conditions to B-2 with Modified Conditions.
2. The conditions accepted by the Applicant are hereby approved and incorporated into the B-2 with Modified Conditions rezoning of the parcel.
3. This ordinance is effective upon adoption.
