#### FY22 and FY23 Funding – Cost Increase Factors

General construction cost escalation

12-inch piping required on numerous projects when initial estimating for applications assumed 6-inch/8-inch piping

Easement acquisition costs – prior SWL program required non-applicants to donate easements

Market uncertainty due to tariffs
