Re: DRAFT - Additional Bond Fund Projects at East Elementary and Forest Hills High

Bond sales from the 2022 referendum generated just over \$20 million in bond premiums. Bond premiums can only be used at East Elementary and Forest Hills High School.

Staff has conducted an exposure assessment associated with the above referenced bond projects. After review and discussion with established contractors and project budgets, staff requests authorization to move forward with planning and execution of the listed projects for each school.
