

**ORDINANCE APPROVING REVISION TO THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF UNION
COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) heretofore enacted the “Unified Development Ordinance of Union County, North Carolina,” including any amendments thereto (the “UDO”) and the official Union County Zoning Map (“Zoning Map”); and

WHEREAS, Union County has received a rezoning petition (RZ-2025-006) submitted by Carl and Cindy Needham requesting a revision of the Union County Zoning Map by rezoning a 42.202 acre parcel appearing on the tax map as tax parcel 01-066-020 in the New Salem Township from a combination of RA-40 and Light Industrial (LI) to all RA-40, and

WHEREAS, the Union County Land Use Board considered and made a recommendation concerning approval or denial of the Rezoning Petition; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that approval of the Rezoning Petition and rezoning the portion of the subject parcel from a combination of RA-40 and Light Industrial (LI) to all RA-40 is reasonable and in the public interest, including for those reasons set forth in the contemporaneously adopted consistency and reasonableness statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Union County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. The Zoning Map is hereby amended by rezoning a parcel appearing on the tax map as tax parcel 01-066-020 in the New Salem Township from a combination of RA-40 and Light Industrial (LI) to all RA-40.
2. This ordinance is effective upon adoption.
