60.170-C Stormwater Management

- 1. No development may be constructed or maintained so that such development impedes the natural flow of water from higher adjacent properties.
- 2. No development may be constructed or maintained so that the natural flow of surface waters from such development is discharged in another location. (amended 5-18-2015)
- 3. Post-development stormwater discharge rates at the property boundary of an approved cluster for all developments exceeding one acre of land disturbance or .25 acre of impervious area may not exceed the pre-development rate for the 2-10- and 25,50-year storm events. This regulation does not apply if discharging directly into a FE-MA-regulated floodplain.
